



Political Director

The New Hampshire Democratic Party (NHDP) is seeking a highly motivated Political Director to manage the party's relationships with town and county-level stakeholders, elected officials, and constituency advocates.

The Political Director will report to the Executive Director, work closely with the NHDP Chair, the entire Party team and collaborate with all 2024 campaigns staff. Salary is commensurate with experience with fully-paid health, dental & vision insurance premiums for the staff member.

Key responsibilities will include:

- Manage the Party's external relationships with state leaders, including members of the legislature, grassroots activists, town/county committees and officials, labor groups and constituency advocates to mobilize support and activity for key races in 2024.
- Representing the NHDP at meetings with partner organizations as needed.
- Liaise with the House Democratic Victory Committee, Senate Committee, and other major 2024 campaigns teams to coordinate campaign events and volunteer outreach.
- Oversee political department staff, including Party Affairs Director and Deputy Political Directors, Regional Political Directors, and any more staff assigned.
- Assist with planning and executing major NHDP events, including, but not limited to NHDP State Convention, Fundraising Dinners, and State and Executive Committee Meetings.

Qualifications

- Deep commitment to the Democratic Party and our platform, with a commitment to expanding our supporter base.
- 1-2 cycles of campaign/political experience; experience in New Hampshire, New England, and/or with the New Hampshire Democratic Party a strong plus;
- Demonstrated success managing people and teams in a campaign setting.
- Experience building campaign/political plans that mobilize external partners with data-driven deliverables and.
- Ability to work with diverse constituencies, communities, and perspectives, including ability to facilitate coalition efforts to build consensus.
- Willingness to work evenings and weekends as needed.
- Strong communication skills required.
